WHAT DID YOU LOVE MOST ABOUT WORKING WITH ETERNAL IMAGES?



WHAT IS YOUR BEST ADVICE FOR KEEPING THINGS ON SCHEDULE WHEN THE DAY IS SO BUSY?

Brianne & Wesley say "Give yourself plenty of time to do everything you need to. Have someone you trust to help keep you on track and don't be afraid to delegate tasks to others. We had a master of ceremonies from the venue that really just made everything perfect working in the background."

WHAT WAS YOUR FAVORITE PHOTOGRAPHIC MOMENT?

"There are so many to choose from. One of our favorite photographs is when we are in the grounds and we are holding hands and kissing."



GETTING MARRIED? IT'S ALL ABOUT BEING PREPARED!

- Be sure to have a hair and makeup trial at least a month before your wedding. This will give you peace of mind to know exactly how you will look and give you the opportunity to change things in advance if necessary. Make sure to bring all jewelry to the trial to see how makeup shades work with the pieces.

- Have your florist deliver your flowers to where you are getting ready, not the ceremony venue. Since you never know when the mood will strike for a great photo, you'll want your flowers there and ready to go.

- Find out what the rules for photographs are at the ceremony location. All venues are different, some restricting the location of photographs and even the times in which they are permitted.

- Have you ever thought to arrange your formal photographs to be captured before the ceremony? Getting this step out of the way early in the day frees up the rest of your time and your guests to socialise after your ceremony. We can even organise a Bride and Groom reveal before your group shots, this is a beautiful moment where the groom sees the bride for the first time in a private pre-arranged area. Remember: It's a new age, so it's no longer considered bad luck for the groom to see the bride before your wedding.

- Have food delivered to your getting ready location. It may be hectic, but take the time to have a bite to eat before the wedding since it will be a while before you have the opportunity to nourish yourself during the reception.

- Prepare an emergency bridal kit with clear nail polish, mints, a sewing kit, stain treater, safety/bobby pins, pain reliever, mini deodorant and flat shoes.

- Allowing 50% more time for hair and makeup than you originally anticipated alleviates the number one reason wedding schedules end up running late. This will assure you have plenty of time for all the portraits you want to take before the wedding.

- Make sure you discuss a "rain plan" with your venue just in case Mother Nature doesn't see sunshine in the cards.

A WEDDING DAY PHOTO TIMELINE

A wedding is a whirlwind of events, gone in the blink of an eye. There's nothing more important for a perfectly executed event than an organized timeline. If you are looking to effectively plan out your wedding day with your wedding coordinator or fiancé, here's a look at a typical wedding photo timeline from our point of view. We are here to help assist you in planning out your day so that you don't miss a beat.

18 HOURS BEFORE YOUR CEREMONY

I've just finished packing my equipment and I'm now going over your wedding information form. I will also have a meeting with my assistant to talk about the details of the day.

3 HOURS BEFORE YOUR CEREMONY

My assistant and I leave for the wedding site. The bride's hair and makeup should be well underway to leave plenty of time for family and couple photos.

2 HOURS BEFORE YOUR CEREMONY

We arrive for bridal preparation capturing the finishing touches of hair and makeup and to document the groomsmen making their final preparations. Wedding venue decor will also be photographed, ensuring all those important details have been captured.

30 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR CEREMONY

Here I coordinate with my assistant and set up any equipment we need during the ceremony. We will also capture guests arrival and then take moment with the bride before she enters the ceremony room.

THE FIRST 15 MINUTES AFTER YOUR CEREMONY

Take a moment to reflect you are now husband and wife! We immediately begin photographing candid shots of your guests and your interactions with them, a confetti shot is prioritised here if required.

YOUR FORMAL PHOTOGRAPHS

We begin your formal photography requests, my assistant will direct your guests as per your desired list. Please remember to allow plenty of time, especially if you have a shot list of 12 or more images. Co-operation of your guests is also key. You may want to consider drinks, entertainment or canapes during this interval too.

ALLOW 10 MINS AFTER YOUR FORMAL PHOTOGRAPHS

I am recommended for not only my award winning service but my creative bride and groom only images. Please allow 10mins before the start of your wedding breakfast. a) Just in case your wedding runs late. b) It will provide a short break for you and your husband to have some creative bride and groom only images captured.

WEDDING BREAKFAST ENTRANCE

My assistant and I will enter the dining room before the guests arrive to photograph the cake and floral decor. We also take this time to set up room lights if we find they are needed. Right before the guests arrive we touch base with the catering manager or wedding coordinator to see if there were any last minute changes to the reception schedule. After capturing your entrance we will then leave you and your guests to enjoy your wedding breakfast.

SPEECHES

Whether before or after your meal, at this time we strictly document speeches candidly, capturing the amazing reactions of you and your guests as they unfold.


AFTER YOUR WEDDING BREAKFAST

We may request some additional time with you both to make full use of your wedding venue inside and out and capture those truly imaginative wow images to be remembered! We will continue to capture candid photographs as your evening guests arrive right through to cutting of the cake and into first dance. If you have chosen our photobooth service this too will be set up, ready to go! We are always available for any photo request you may have throughout the evening. Just ask!

YOUR EVENING RECEPTION: 10PM

We pack our equipment and prepare for our departure. But first, we will check with you to make sure there aren't any further photos you would like or an overtime request. We may go outside for a night "time exposure" photograph of the both of you to showcase the beauty of your venue at night.

Two weeks before your wedding we will touch base via phone or e-mail to discuss your wedding day photo timeline. At this time we will also provide you with our online wedding day questionnaire to fill out with all your wedding details including locations, family members, special wedding day events, vendors and much more. This information will ensure we are all on the same page for an unforgettable and stress-free event!







THE DIVA'S IN THE DETAILS

FROM BOOKING TO COLLECTION

The weeks prior to and directly following your wedding planning are busy times. Here at Eternal Images Photography® we honor your wedding with a special timeline which will help you to understand how we are working our hardest to avoid any unnecessary surprises:

Ten weeks before your wedding: Ensure your pre wedding shoot is booked no later than ten weeks before your wedding at a location of your choice.

Two weeks before your wedding: After discussing any last minute specifications, we send you a online wedding information form to fill out all the details most important to you for capturing the best images possible.

Two days before your wedding: We will confirm all the details from the schedule and your wedding form.

The day of your wedding: We arrive at the scheduled time and quickly run through the course of the day. Then we coordinate with your family and friends regarding scheduled start times for formal portraits and what to expect.

A week after your wedding: We will post a sneak preview of your wedding images via our wedding day blog. Your images will then begin the post production stage where they will be edited, retouched, archived and prepared for your online gallery or proofs.

Three weeks after your wedding: We deliver your online wedding gallery proofs information. With optional album buying information.

Five weeks after your wedding: You should inform us whether you would like to purchase a wedding day album and return your chosen album booking form with payment.

**If you choose not to purchase an optional album your wedding images will be provided on a heart shaped USB and posted special delivery within the week.*

Ten weeks after your wedding: You should select your album images and we will begin your album design proof.

Twelve weeks after your wedding: We will send you an online album design proof for you to review the page styles. We can also use this opportunity to take orders for portraits, wedding party member gifts, parent albums, and any of the other unique keepsakes we offer.

Six weeks from album design approval: Your album and artwork are ready for pickup or delivery! At this time we also provide a client care card packet which will ensure a long life for your precious heirlooms.

STRIKE A POSE

Here at Eternal Images Photography Ltd[®] we pride ourselves in capturing the most natural, candid portraiture possible. This style showcases your day as it was, helping to bring your personalities forward and documenting your day for a lifetime of memories.

While we shoot the majority of our images this way, it's also very important to capture traditional formal portraits as well. Since our most important goal is keeping your wedding on schedule, we allow 3-5 minutes for each desired grouping to ensure maximum results with minimal time. (Make sure all flowers and boutannaire are delivered on time and affixed to family members and to the wedding party in advance.)

Because we prefer to keep the number of groups to 12 or less for more intimate group shots, we always start with the largest group and break it down afterwards. My assistant will inform your guests whether they are needed to reduce any misunderstandings and allow for socialising.

If time permits, we love to include a picture of the bride with each of her bridesmaids and the groom with each of his groomsmen, since each person has been invited due to close, personal ties with the couple.


